

SIBLING 10% TUITION DISCOUNT

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- For each sibling, 10% of tuition will be discounted.
- Eligible siblings are two or more brothers or sisters who are concurrently enrolled as full-time undergraduate degree students at Seton Hall. The siblings must be dependent students who reside in the same household.
- Each eligible sibling is required to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FASA) each year for which the discount is requested.
- The discount may be used for fall and spring semesters only; summer sessions are not covered.
- If one sibling has not completed 24 credits in the last 12 months, or if one sibling is placed on probation for 2 consecutive semesters, neither sibling is eligible for the discount.
- Discounts will be approved for the academic year, but eligibility will be calculated on a semester basis. For example, if one sibling graduates in December, or does not enroll full-time for the spring semester, the discount is not valid for the spring semester.
- If an eligible sibling is receiving a full tuition scholarship, e.g. ROTC, Chancellor's, or Martin Luther King, the sibling discount will not be approved. However, the other eligible sibling(s) discount will be approved.
- There will be no transfer of sibling discount, such as one receiving 20% and the other 0%. All discounts will be at 10% per sibling.
- Seton Hall University employees and their children are not eligible.
- Each family must file an application before the beginning of every academic year for which the discount
